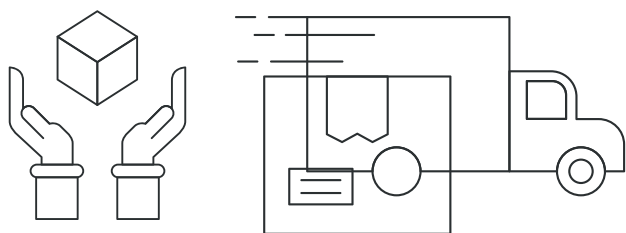


PACKING CHECKLIST

01: Things to Do Before You Start Packing

- Create a moving timeline
- Declutter every room before packing
- Separate items to donate, sell, or throw away
- Measure large furniture and doorways
- Create a folder for important documents
- Set aside medications and valuables
- Prepare a first-night essentials bag
- Take photos of electronics and cable setups
- Plan your room by room packing order

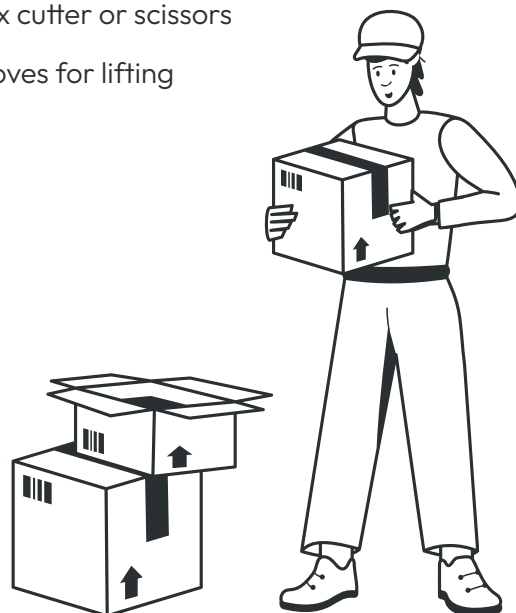


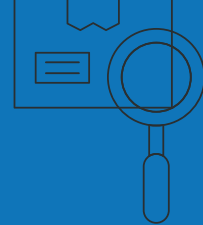
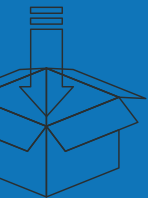
02: Gather the Right Packing Supplies

- Small moving boxes
- Medium moving boxes
- Large moving boxes
- Heavy-duty boxes for fragile items
- Wardrobe boxes
- Packing tape
- Tape dispenser
- Bubble wrap
- Packing paper
- Stretch wrap
- Furniture blankets
- Permanent markers
- Labels or stickers
- Zip bags for screws and small parts
- Mattress covers
- Trash bags
- Cleaning supplies
- Box cutter or scissors
- Gloves for lifting

03: How to Pack for a Move

- Start with items you rarely use
- Pack one room at a time
- Label every box clearly
- Use smaller boxes for heavy items
- Wrap fragile items properly
- Fill empty spaces inside boxes
- Do not overpack boxes
- Keep important documents with you
- Pack an essentials box for moving day
- Keep daily-use items accessible until the end
- Double-check every room before moving day

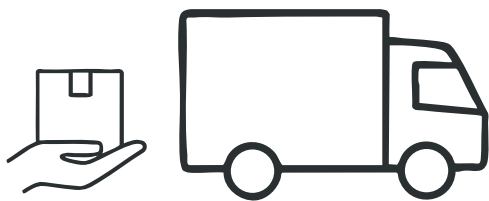




ROOM-BY-ROOM PACKING CHECKLIST

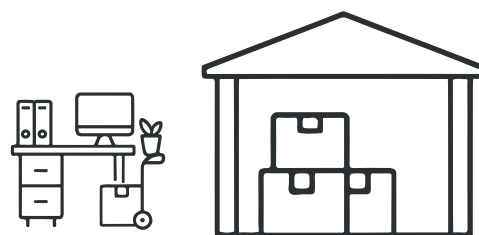
01: Kitchen

- Pack seasonal or less-used kitchen items first
- Wrap plates and glasses individually
- Label fragile kitchen boxes clearly
- Pack canned food in small boxes
- Secure appliance cords properly
- Empty and clean the refrigerator
- Throw away expired food items
- Keep basic kitchen essentials unpacked until the last day



02: Bedroom

- Pack off-season clothes first
- Use wardrobe boxes for hanging clothes
- Pack shoes separately
- Store jewelry in secure containers
- Keep daily outfits accessible
- Pack bedding and linens together
- Set aside chargers and personal essentials
- Keep valuables with you instead of moving boxes



03: Living Room

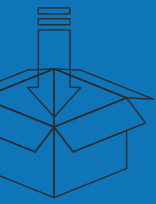
- Pack decorations and books first
- Label all electronic cables
- Take photos of TV and electronics setups
- Wrap TVs and fragile décor carefully
- Remove detachable furniture parts
- Store screws and hardware in labeled bags
- Protect furniture with blankets or wrap
- Keep remotes and accessories together



04: Bathroom

- Throw away expired toiletries and medicines
- Pack extra towels and backup products first
- Seal liquids in plastic bags
- Keep medications accessible
- Pack cleaning supplies separately
- Keep daily toiletries out until moving day
- Use towels to cushion fragile items
- Prepare a small bathroom essentials bag for the first night





FIRST NIGHT ESSENTIALS BOX

Keep this box with you or load it last so it is the first thing you can access after arriving at your new home.

Bedroom

- Bedsheets and pillows
- Blanket or comforter
- Pajamas
- Change of clothes
- Phone chargers
- Alarm clock
- Extension cord or power strip



Bathroom

- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Soap and shampoo
- Towels
- Toilet paper
- Medications
- First aid kit
- Hairbrush and personal care items



Kitchen

- Paper plates and cups
- Plastic utensils
- Coffee maker or kettle
- Snacks and bottled water
- Dish soap and sponge
- Bottle opener
- Basic cooking essentials



Cleaning Supplies

- All-purpose cleaner
- Paper towels
- Trash bags
- Hand soap
- Cleaning wipes
- Broom or dustpan



Tools

- Screwdriver set
- Scissors
- Box cutter
- Hammer
- Tape measure
- Flashlight
- Extra batteries



Important Documents

- IDs and passports
- Lease or house documents
- Insurance papers
- Moving company paperwork
- Pet records
- Valuables and jewelry
- Emergency contact information
